Montex JV (Joint Venture)


The stenter frame presented here is manufactured by Monforts Fong's Textile Machinery Co. Ltd., Hong Kong in Shenzhen. This Joint Venture company was founded in 1998 and has become one of the largest suppliers of stenters in the PR of China. The Montex JV model is Monforts design and largely identical with the stenter frame marketed under the name of Monfongs in China, of which almost 800 machines have been sold.

Buyers outside China get a stenter with some minor technical modifications to suit local conditions. Customers receive the stenter frame Montex JV exclusively from A. Monforts Textilmaschinen GmbH & Co. KG with CE conformity declaration, if required. Installation and service, operation and maintenance manuals as well as replacement parts and parts subject to increased wear and tear are provided by the well known


service team of A. Monforts Textilmaschinen in Mönchengladbach with the diligence and high quality you are accustomed to.





High Tech stentering chains




Hercules Horizontally Return Stentering Chain



Two bowl pad mangle. Suitable for finishing and dehydration processes. For woven and/or knitted fabrics.




Stenter infeed section

Short controlled fabric guidance for optimum feeding of even extremely delicate knitted fabrics. Uniform pinning by two driven draw rollers in the infeed unit.



Infeed track lenghts

Up to 6 m to take auxiliary equipment; e.g. selvedge gumming device, steaming unit etc.




For woven fabrics: 2 guide rollers

Fabric preparation


- Large overfeed pinning adjustment range (-10% to +60%) to accommodate the various amounts of shrinkage encountered in different fabrics.
- The selvedge tension can be set separately for the left-hand and right-hand side control




Fabric run: Clip operation

The TwinAir System


Characteristics: Separately controlled air flow for top and bottom air

Air volume is being controlled by frequency inverters




Chamber Design








Lint filter system



Accessories for knitted fabrics finishing



Selvedge gumming unit with reservoir for minimum glue application

Small-volume working tank with automatic filling level control airtight reservoir (interchangeable). Thus no drying-out of the glue.




Selvedge cutting device

For minimum cut of the glued selvedges by rotating cutting blades. High performance suction system for waste removal

Without illustration:

- Steaming device at stenter inlet section
- Fabric supporting rope in the infeed section

Options for knitted fabrics finishing




High performance selvedge dryer

- For energy-saving supplementary drying of glued and salt-impregnated selvedges
- Heating up and cooling down within seconds
- Suitable for woven and knitted fabrics

With driven pulling roller and plaiter. Also available with ascending batch winder on cardboard tubes up to 600 mm diameter.
